ABOUT OUR MISSION

Cancer Support Community uplifts and strengthens people impacted by cancer by providing support, fostering compassionate communities, and breaking down barriers to care. Our impact speaks volumes. Last year alone, we served over 7,000 individuals and families, providing more than 12,000 program visits across our OH-KY-IN Tri-State region. But numbers only tell part of the story. It's the smiles, the renewed hope, and the sense of belonging that truly define our work.

THE NEED FOR CSC

Each day, an estimated 60 people in our Tri-State region hear the words, "You have cancer." For many, that moment marks the beginning of an emotional, social, and financial crisis - not just a medical journey. National studies show that up to one in three people with cancer experience clinically significant anxiety or depression, yet fewer than half receive the mental health support they need to cope and stay engaged in treatment. Too often, people facing cancer feel isolated, overwhelmed, and unsure where to turn.

CSC exists to change that. We provide free, evidence-based, culturally responsive psychosocial care - support groups, navigation, education, and healthy lifestyle programs - for patients, survivors, and their loved ones. By surrounding each person with a community of support, CSC helps reduce distress, improve quality of life, and increase the likelihood that individuals can complete and benefit from their medical care.

Cancer Support Community delivers hope, healing, and connection to individuals and families navigating cancer throughout Greater Cincinnati, Northern Kentucky and Southeastern Indiana.

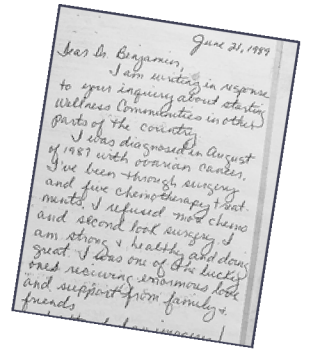


OUR HISTORY & GROWTH

Our global network traces its roots to a yellow house in Santa Monica, California, where Harriet and Dr. Harold Benjamin transformed the way our culture faces cancer. After Harriet's diagnosis with cancer in 1972, Dr. Benjamin sought to create a community that would provide social and emotional support to cancer patients and their families and friends — all free of charge. In 1982, The Wellness Community opened its doors in California.

During this time a local woman and cancer survivor, Lynn Stern, saw an interview with Dr. Benjamin on the Phil Donahue Show and **in 1990, with help of friends & family, launched the first Wellness Community in our region, bringing critical services and support to the Greater Cincinnati-Northern Kentucky area.**

In a heartfelt letter to Dr. Benjamin, Lynn expressed, **"No one understands like someone who's been there. And no one should have to go through this alone."** Impressed and inspired by TWC's philosophy, approach, and impact, Lynn was determined to bring this organization to the Greater Cincinnati community.



Meanwhile, Gilda Radner, the late comedian and original "Saturday Night Live", benefited from The Wellness Community after being diagnosed with ovarian cancer in 1986. Her experience inspired her to call for similar support-focused organizations. Although Radner passed away in 1989, her husband, Gene Wilder along with other friends and family, answered her call to action. Together, they founded Gilda's Club New York City and opened its iconic Red Door in 1995.

In July 2009, The Wellness Community and Gilda's Club Worldwide joined forces to become the Cancer Support Community (CSC). By helping to complete the cancer care plan, CSC optimizes patient care by providing essential, but often overlooked, services including support groups, counseling, education and healthy lifestyle programs. The worldwide organization provides the highest quality emotional and social support through a network of more than 190 satellite and office locations.

Today, Cancer Support Community Greater Cincinnati Northern Kentucky enhance the lives of thousands of individuals and families affected by a cancer diagnosis and continues to grow, most recently expanding services to Dayton, Ohio and South Dearborn, Indiana!
